SHOW RULES AND REGULATIONS ~ PLEASE READ!!

***All animals MUST be in place by 9am**, be kept neat and must remain on display until 5pm when the museum closes. Exhibitors who wish to stay for the entire weekend are welcome. Contact Pete Snyder for details. All vehicles and trailers MUST be off the grounds before 10am when the museum opens and parked in the designated area. Exhibitors and their immediate family will be admitted free of charge on the museum grounds as long as they are exhibiting animals. Anyone not exhibiting animals must enter through the main gate and pay the regular admission fee. **NO DOGS ALLOWED.**

***Facilities** include a large tent with a limited number of collapsible wooden pens. Pen space is very limited, first come first serve. Please arrive early and plan to pen several does in the same pen to allow adequate space for other exhibitors. Exhibitors who have portable pens are welcome to bring them. Bedding straw will be available.

Entry Fees- \$5.00 per entry ~ Dairy Herd class \$5.00 per entry. ~ No fee for Best Udder class.

****Late entry fee if entry is postmarked or received after 9/25/18 is \$10.00- no exceptions.**

***No refunds-** Substitutions allowed in the same breed. All goats must be health checked and checked in with the Show Secretaries by 9:30am. The show will begin at 10:00am.

***The show order** will be A, L, ND, N, O, S, T, RG. **The order of show is not subject to change.** The CGS Combined Jr./Sr. Doe Show is sanctioned by CGS and their rules shall govern. Only ADGA/AGS/CGS registered, recorded, or applied for animals shall be shown. The base date for computing all ages is October 6, 2018.

***The original** registration certificate is required for all animals and must be presented to the secretary before the start of the show. An ADGA stamped duplicate or facsimile copy of the application for registration is only acceptable for doe kids under 6 months of age. Horned animals are not permitted.

***The GCDGC** has no authority to monitor interstate transportation regulations; however, no animal may unload without a thorough inspection by the health check committee. **NO EXCEPTIONS PLEASE.** The health check committee reserves the right to reject any animals found to have signs of communicable disease (abscesses, soremouth, ringworm, etc.). In the event of such signs, all animals from the herd or common carrier shall be immediately removed from the show premises by the exhibitor. No refunds will be allowed. Please check your entries carefully before transporting. **Each exhibitor is responsible for cleaning up their area before leaving the facilities.** No unauthorized dumping of milk on fairgrounds. If you have milk to dump, please ask. By order of the Fire Marshall, there will be absolutely no smoking in any building/tent on the premises.

***Paid entry indicates acceptance of the show rules and regulations.** The show committee reserves the right to interpret any rules not adequately covered by these or CGS rules. GCDGC show committee, Genesee Country Museum or any members or affiliates of these groups cannot be held responsible for all or any loss, damage, injury, or accident to any person, animal, vehicle, or property while on the fairgrounds or on route to the fairgrounds. All animals are entered at the sole risk of the exhibitor or owner. Anyone violating show rules, as well as any immediate family member or animals owned by them, will not be allowed to participate or attend GCDGS events for a period of three years. If the violation is for non-payment of entry fees, stall fees, etc, then the exhibitor and all immediate family members, and any and all animals owned by them, will be prohibited from attending GCDGS events for a period of three years from the date of payment and/or reimbursement.

***DIRECTIONS:** The Genesee Country Village and Museum is conveniently located on Flint Hill Rd in Mumford, NY near three major interstate highways and just 20 minutes southwest of Rochester, NY. The museum can be reached from the NYS Thruway via exit 47 (Leroy) or from the south via Avon exit 10 from the I 390. There are many signs near the villages of Caledonia and Mumford.
